Pursuant to Section 10-7 (B) of the City Charter

WHEREAS, Section 10-7 (B) of the Norwalk Charter provides that the City Council may by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the entire membership of the Council amend the maximum limit of total appropriations in whole or by acting on the components of such maximum limits as set forth in Sect. 10-5A(1) and (2).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWALK THAT:

The maximum limit on the total appropriation for the City of Norwalk's General Fund for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026, shall be no more than \$479,486,926. Be it further resolved that the result of this vote and resolution be forwarded by the Clerk of the City of Norwalk to the Board of Estimate and Taxation.
