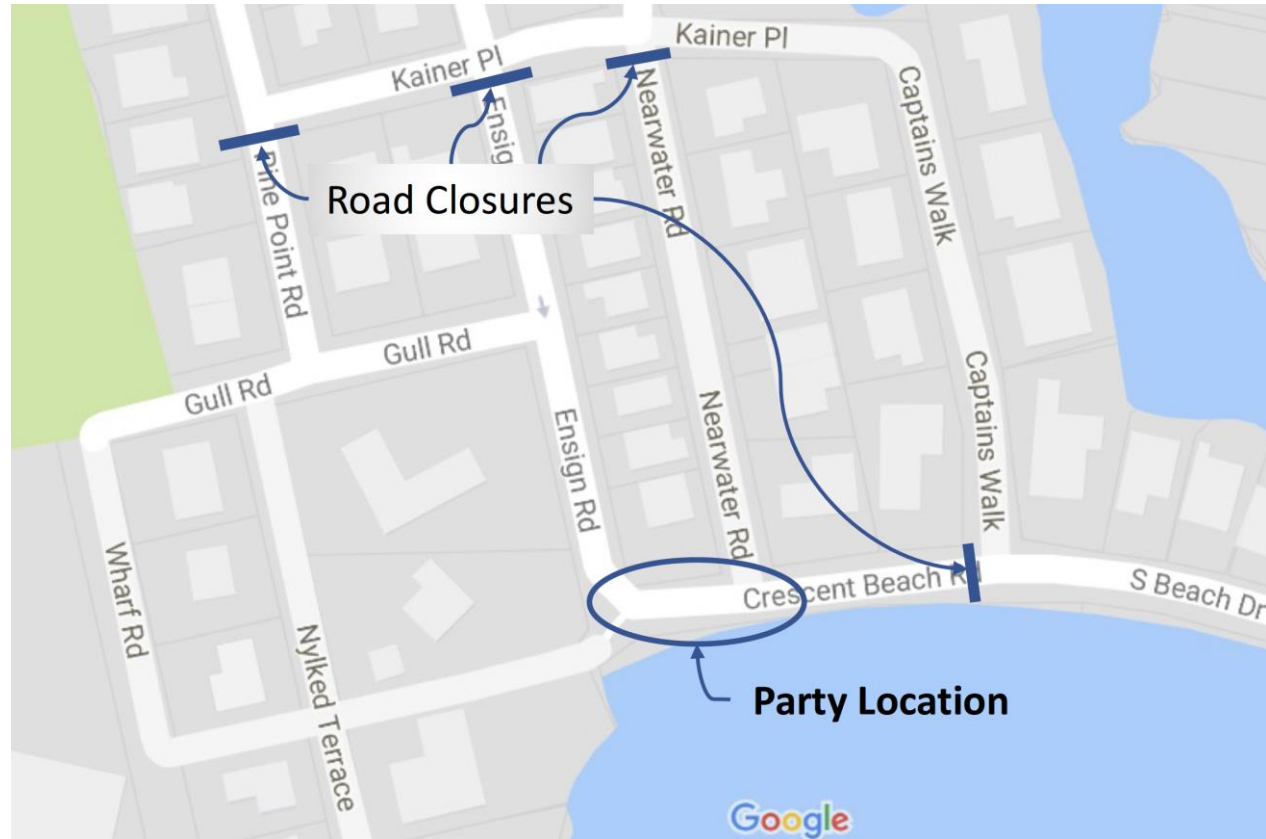

The Norwalk Redevelopment Agency and the City of Norwalk would like to inform residents, businesses, and motorists of anticipated construction activities associated taking place on Orchard Street, Butler Street and Quincy Street.

Sidewalk Construction

Sidewalk construction is underway on Butler Street and is anticipated to continue through approximately July 31, 2026. Upon completion of Butler Street, construction will move to Quincy Street to continue sidewalk improvements.

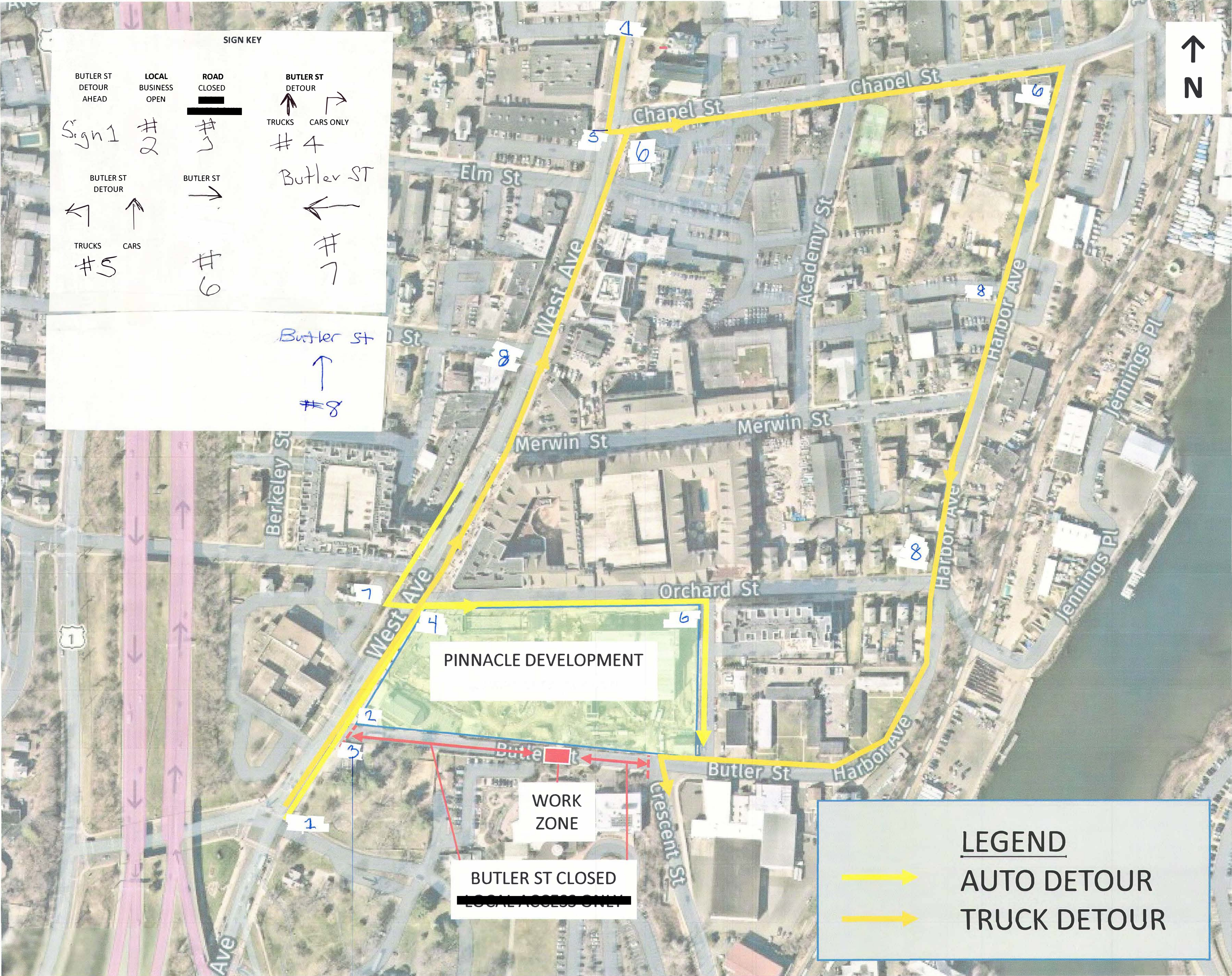

The City of Norwalk is writing to request a review of the speed limit on the following roads in the general area of Silvermine Avenue:

- **Silvermine Avenue from Belair Road to Perry Avenue**

TMP is requesting that Silvermine Avenue, from Belair Road to Perry Avenue, be considered for a 25 MPH speed limit. Silvermine Avenue functions as a city collector that provides access between New Canaan and Norwalk through the Silvermine neighborhood. Establishing a 25 MPH limit on this roadway segment would create a consistent speed limit along the entire corridor. The current OSTA Approvals of Silvermine Ave are as follows:

The New Canaan portion of the roadway along with the northern and southern sections of Silvermine Ave are currently approved for 25 MPH speed limits. In an effort to bring consistency and improve driver behavior, TMP is requesting the “middle” existing portion of Silvermine Ave from Perry Ave to Belair be considered for a 25 MPH speed limit.

Silvermine Avenue is primarily low-density and residential roadways with neighboring low-volume local roadways. Many reported crashes are influenced by limited visibility around nighttime and curves in the roadway. A lower speed limit would support safer conditions for all road users and would reinforce the City's broader efforts to calm traffic and enhance connectivity within the Silvermine area.

TMP is requesting that the above-mentioned portions of each road be considered for a 25 MPH speed limit. These roads are being requested to help further align with the surrounding road speed limits. All of these are local roads where speeds do not exceed 30 MPH. Lowering the speed limit to 25 MPH would make it enforceable to properly follow the speed the roadways allow. These roadways also are near the towns of Wilton and New Canaan, which have their roadways approved at 25 MPH. Lowering the speed limit would promote uniformity in speed limits, safety for all road users, including pedestrians, and support the City's broader efforts to improve traffic calming and connectivity throughout the area.
