NEW BUSINESS

A. Update: Norwalk 2050 Sustainability and Resilience Roadmap. Ms. Trendler reported staff review is underway, with weekly department-head meetings through September; the roadmap is expected to serve as the foundation for the next POCD update rather than an amendment to the current one, with community outreach this fall and presentation to Council targeted for December 8, 2026. She will circulate chapters to the Committee for input as they are finalized. No formal action taken.

B. Recommendation Discussion: Skip the Stuff Possible Ordinance.

The Committee discussed alternatives to an ordinance, including a voluntary pilot program paired with a public education campaign and possible integration with the Health Department for enforcement, and noted Westport and Greenwich have related local rules and that a similar bill was tabled at

the state level in April. Chair Lopez will circulate a framework for further discussion at a future meeting. No formal action taken.
