I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Rilling called the meeting to order at 12:01 PM.

The proposed closure was presented, and it was said that this closure will be the same as the holiday extravaganza. She said the closures will take place on July 26th, August 30th, and September 27th. Mayor Rilling asked what the hours of the closure would be. Ms. Breault said from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Commissioner Collier-Clemmons asked if this is a new event. Ms. Breault said, “Yes” and it is happening on the last Saturday of each summer month. The first one was held in June, but it did not close the street and just used the lawn at 50 Washington Street. However, the event has grown and will now need to close the street. Mayor Rilling asked if the businesses in the area would be notified. Ms. Breault said, “Yes.” Commissioner Collier-Clemmons asked how far in advance they would be notified. Ms. Breault said either today or tomorrow.
