

Five Mile River Commission
January 15, 2026 Meeting Minutes

The Five Mile River Commission commenced its regularly scheduled meeting at the Rowayton Community Center at 6:03 p.m.

Chairman Marion requested the Commissioners ratify their prior online approval of the December 11, 2025 meeting minutes and the Commission's protocol for the planned dock dredging of 89 and 93 Five Mile River Rd. Commissioner Jessup so moved, Commissioner DeRegt seconded, and the Commission unanimously approved the minutes and dredging protocol.

Next, the Commission discussed a request for commercial moorings from a local business and agreed to table the request pending receipt of additional information from the applicant.

The Commission then discussed the following topics in Harbor Superintendent Griffiths' January 2026 report: (i) initial responses regarding the 2026 mooring and slip applications and mooring inspection forms; (ii) the updated mooring map (end of 2025) and distribution of mooring permittees among marine service providers (MSPs); (iii) discussions with MSPs regarding the proposed temporary relocation of moorings during the dock dredging operation at 89 and 93 Five Mile River; (iv) meetings with MSPs regarding 2026 mooring inspections; and (v) the 2026 operating budget.

By unanimous vote, the Commission then commenced executive session to discuss personnel matters for 2026. No votes were taken by the Commission during the session.

With no further business, the Commission adjourned its meeting at 6:50 pm. The Commission's next scheduled meeting will be held on Thursday, February 19, 2026, commencing at 6:00 p.m. at Rowayton Community Center, 33 Highland Avenue, Norwalk, CT.
