

Five Mile River Commission
February 19, 2026 Meeting Minutes

The Five Mile River Commission commenced its regularly scheduled meeting at the Rowayton Community Center at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Marion requested the Commissioners ratify their prior online approval of the January 15, 2026 meeting minutes and the Commission's January 29, 2026 submission to the Connecticut Port Authority (CPA). Commissioner Jung so moved, Commissioner DeRegt seconded, and the Commission's quorum unanimously approved its January 2026 minutes and the CPA submission.

Next, the Commission tabled the request for commercial moorings from a local business pending receipt of additional information from the applicant. The Commission then discussed the following topics in Harbor Superintendent Griffiths' February 2026 report: (i) the 2026 mooring and slip applications and mooring inspection program; (ii) its February financials; (iii) the delayed dock dredging operation at 89 and 93 Five Mile River; (iv) meetings with MSPs regarding 2026 mooring inspections; and (v) the 2026 operating budget.

By unanimous vote, the Commission then commenced executive session to discuss personnel matters for 2026. The Commission voted unanimously, with Commissioner Jessup's proxy, to approve increased compensation and revised responsibilities for the Commission's staff.

With no further business, the Commission adjourned its meeting. The Commission's next scheduled meeting will be held on Thursday, March 19, 2026, commencing at 6:00 p.m. at Rowayton Community Center, 33 Highland Avenue, Norwalk, CT.
