Mr. Camacho called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m.

Mr. Lo reviewed the history of the building at 98 South Main Street. He explained that the YMCA had submitted a proposal to use the building for community uses; however, there were financial challenges, and they are no longer able to go through with their project. This request will allow the City to operate the building until the end of the fiscal year.

Mr. Camacho asked if there were any plans for the building since the YMCA backed out. Mayor Rilling said he is working with the Boys and Girls Club of Stamford to see if it is possible to make it a satellite space.

Mr. Lo said that it costs about \$80,000 annually to run the building, including the cost of snow removal. He added that it is essential to maintain the building by keeping the heat and hot water running.

Mr. Frayer said that when the agreement with the YMCA was approved, it was almost a done deal. Mayor Rilling said the original renovation estimates came in higher than anticipated and they were not successful with their capital campaign. He said he reached out to the Stamford Boys and Girls Club to see if they would be interested in providing programs in the building.

Mr. Lo described the original agreement between the City of Norwalk and the YMCA and said that after Covid, the project costs went up significantly. Mayor Rilling said the Boys and Girls Club also felt the estimate was high and there is a local developer who believes they can come in significantly lower. Mr. Lo said the YMCA spent a few hundred thousand dollars on this project.

Ms. D'Amore reviewed the request to cover the insurance cost for their WIC employees. Last year a change was made in their health insurance, and it was more expensive. They realized they needed additional funds to cover those overages. She said there are enough funds in other accounts to cover the overages. This request is to approve the transfer of funds to the correct account.

Ms. Rodriguez said these changes to their insurance were made during their open enrollment. This was caught midway and brought to Ms. D'Amore.

- Oak Hills Park Budget – September 2022

Mr. Dutton reviewed their financials. The biggest expense was for water. He reported that they are making payments to the City.

Mr. Frayer pointed out that the accounts receivables were up by \$37,000. Mr. Dutton said that raises somewhat of an issue. They are owed by the licensee for the restaurant from the first quarter of the fiscal year. They are owed about \$26 - \$31,000. Mr. Dutton said they approached the licensee and they said they were not doing as well as they thought. He said they met to see what they could do to help them; however, it has been silent for a few weeks.

Mr. Jellerette said he felt the deal was extraordinary for them and is surprised and not happy about this. Mr. Camacho said it sounds like it is not going to work out.

Mr. Jellerette recommended they work very quickly to remedy this situation and if not, they should act on it.

Mr. Jellerette asked about the openings on the Oak Hills Park Authority. Mr. Dutton said he believes they have three openings. Mr. Jellerette offered to keep sending names to the Mayor for the positions on the Oak Hills Park Authority.

Mayor Rilling left the meeting at 7:12 PM

Mr. Jellerette asked about upcoming capital projects. Mr. Dutton said they are looking at getting 2 golf simulators. There are no other major capital projects planned at this time. Mr. Jellerette asked about the status of the unlimited program this year. Mr. Dutton said the number of rounds are down from the people who purchased unlimited rounds last year. He said it is good to do because it helps the cash flow

Mr. Dutton talked about staffing and said the general managers opening is under negotiations. Mr. Jellerette said this position needs to be filled. He asked if the restaurant could publish its hours of operation. Mr. Dutton said he told them they need to be opened during the core hours but he has not heard back from them. Mr. Frayer asked how the licensee does at the Silvermine Golf Club. Mr. Dutton said he heard that their governance is not as happy as they have been in the past. Mr. Frayer said he heard the same thing. Mr. Dutton said going forward they will develop a very strong RFP. Mr. Frayer said we were told that there are very few people who were interested. Mr. Dutton said there are opportunities at Oak Hills.

Re: Transfer Requests – Additional Funds for Zoning Regulations Rewrite

Over the past eighteen months, the City has been engaged in a complete overhaul of the zoning regulations. The existing regulations were last updated around thirty years ago.

We have been working with a consultant, Town Planning & Urban Design Collaborative (TPUDC), on the regulations rewrite and we are close to issuing the public draft, to begin the adoption process. Out of an abundance of caution, we felt it was appropriate to hire an outside attorney to conduct a secondary legal review of the document, prior to its release, due to the scope of the rewrite and the numerous and significant regulatory changes to the state's zoning enabling statutes and related land use changes that have occurred over the past year. In addition, there are some additional tasks we would like TPUDC to conduct prior to adoption, such as additional meeting attendance and edits beyond what was initially anticipated.

The Corporation Counsel's office connected us with a respected land use attorney, Mark Branse, from Halloran & Sage who will be conducting the legal review for the City.

We are requesting a transfer of \$40,000 from our Salaries F/T account (013730-5110) to Architectural/Landscaping (013730-5254) for the additional legal services and additional consulting services related to the regulations rewrite. \$20,000 will be budgeted for legal services and \$20,000 budgeted for the zoning edits. We are also considering some additional Adobe software licenses for future edits of the final zoning document. I do not believe that the entire sum will be spent for either service but want to allow additional funds for contingency purposes.

Presently, we have a vacant Zoning Assistant position, with a salary of \$63,837. I have purposely kept that position vacant because we hired three (3) new, entry to near entry level staff earlier this year, so we did not wish to try and train four individuals at one time. We anticipate revisiting the timing of the hire this Spring, when construction activity usually increases. In addition, our 3 recent hires all started in August of this fiscal year, so there is additional savings from those salaries within the current budget.

October 2022 Financial Commentary

Operations Updates:

- Golf rounds are nearly 2% over budget for the first four months of FY23. Cart rentals and discount ID card sales also exceeded expectations slightly. Dry weather and the current popularity of golf helped push rounds so high.
- OHPA is planning on some capital improvement expenditures as we head into the off-season.

YTD Financial Highlights:

- FY23 YTD net operating income was over budget by \$157k and we ended October with a \$628k cash balance.
 - Revenue was over-budget by \$140k thanks to strong golf and cart rounds.
 - Expenses were \$17k lower than budget due to lower than expected wages as a result of being understaffed; offset by very high water expense due to the dry, hot conditions.
- OHPA made \$55k in repayments to the City for the first four months of this fiscal year. The annual 1% of gross golf revenue additional debt payment was made in November.

Other:

- The annual fiscal audit is complete with another favorable report issued in early November.
- Our LOC expires in Nov so the Controller is working with our bank to do the standard annual extension.

As of the end of September, 2022, having concluded the first three months of the fiscal year, we collected in excess of \$194 million against our \$362.6 million adjusted levy, or **53.58%**. We also collected **50.64%** of our sewer use levy, more than \$8.9 million, and **74.23%** of the Industrial Pretreatment Program (IPP) fee billing on behalf of the WPCA. Compared with the prior fiscal year (September, 2021) we are very slightly behind relative to taxes (-.04%). We are slightly ahead with sewer use (+.17%); and behind with the IPP fee (-5.29%).

With regard to prior years' collections, through the end of September 2022, we show a net collection more than \$1.4 million since July 1, 2022. This amount is more than \$1 million less than what we collected during the first quarter of the prior fiscal year. This variance is expected, since we held a tax sale in October 2021, and the disparity is directly attributable to the robust payment activity involved with the tax sale.

Delinquent notices, called "demand for payment" notices, were sent to Norwalk taxpayers in September. The term, "demand" is a statutory term, and is not meant to imply rudeness to the taxpayer. The tax collector is required to "make demand" for payment prior to initiating collection enforcement measures. We are continuing to issue alias tax warrants for selected accounts owing past due business personal property taxes. These are served by a state marshal. We issue approximately 25 warrants per month during non-collection months. In conjunction with this, last month we published a tax collector's notice of levy in the local newspaper, listing those business personal property accounts that have been turned over to the state marshals for collection. All of the accounts listed owed either in excess of \$1,000; or were past due two or more years. This was done to notify not only the taxpayers, but also other creditors that the property is subject to levy and seizure for back taxes.

We also continue to pursue our health permit initiative for business establishments owing back taxes that have been delinquent for at least one year. We also expect to begin working with the collection agency approved by the Common Council earlier this year; that endeavor will likely take place within the next four to six weeks.

The tax sale site at [City of Norwalk Tax Sale 2021 \(arcgis.com\)](http://CityofNorwalkTaxSale2021.arcgis.com) remains active online. Our next tax sale is scheduled to be held on July 17, 2023. We will begin work on that sale next month. Maintaining high current and back tax collection rates promotes budgetary stability, and allows the Board of Estimate and Taxation to set lower mill rates for all taxpayers. A higher current collection rate enables less of an allowance for "uncollectible" taxes, and correspondingly lower mill rates.

With the assistance of the IT Division, we implemented an upgrade to the Munis property tax software system over the Columbus Day weekend. This was necessary, as the prior version of the software will no longer be supported by the vendor. This upgrade should be distinguished from a separate endeavor, namely our conversion to a new software system that is scheduled to occur in March and April 2023. That conversion involves only the assessment and collection divisions, and does not affect other city departments that will continue to use the

Munis financial and other systems. We have scheduled the upgrade and the conversion for times that will cause the least amount of disruption for the public, and the least amount of duplicate effort in our divisions. We will continue to work closely with the other divisions involved, as this is a group effort.

We are also looking ahead to the month of November, a short month with three holidays, and the time when we usually run the files for the second installment billing. Ideally, we like to have bills in the mail by December 10 . However, this will depend on the work schedules and progress in the assessor's division, as we need to coordinate with them. Their division relies on receiving data from the Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles for newly registered vehicles that are added to the tax rolls subsequent to the "grand list" date of October 1, 2021 (first time registration, not registration renewed). Those vehicles need to be priced, in some cases, and there is other work involved to prevent duplicate billings. Having our bills out at the regular time will help streamline and even expedite the collection cycle, with an eye toward the software conversion in March 2023. Looking ahead to that time, we hope to get delinquent notices in the mail in early to mid-February 2023, and file our lien continuing certificates by the first week of March 2023, in advance of the software conversion later that month.

We are still short staffed and have two vacancies out of our eight person staff. We expect to fill those vacancies within the next few months, prior to the second installment collection cycle.

I am prepared to respond to any questions, and will continue to keep all stakeholders informed of our progress.
