1. Call to Order
2. Approve [Reject] proposal from Sturges Brothers and the Norwalk Preservation Trust regarding 319 Flax Hill Road:
 - A) Sturges Brothers will recreate the 18th century façade of the residence, reusing some original materials from the existing structure, including the elliptical window and front door, and provide 12 over 12 paned windows.
 - B) Sturges Brothers will provide measured drawings of the entire existing structure (excluding the barn/garage) by a licensed architect.
 - C) The Norwalk Preservation Trust will provide large format photographic documentation of the interior and exterior of the structure.

One copy of the drawings and photography will be delivered to the Norwalk History Room at the Norwalk Public Library. Upon completion of the measured drawings and photography, advise the Building Inspector to lift the demolition delay.
